PROFESSIONAL SUMMARY

Daniel is an SAP Mentor, recognized by SAP as an active participant in the community. He is one of the most active participants in the SAP community to help improve the product and services of SAP. He has been blogging about how to use SAP PI/PRO and has been active in the documentation part of PI.

Daniel has been working with all versions from SAP XI 3.0, PI (Process Integration) 7.0, 7.1, 7.31 and PO 7.4, 7.5 as the primary focus. He has been involved with 20+ projects/installation, working with most of platform tools. He has gained a reputation from his colleagues for being able to solve problems occurred on the PI/PRO system. To implement the functionalities he needed for the projects, Daniel has worked with the following;

- Java stack only with PI 7.31 and PO 7.5
- BPMN process development and aBPM
- SAPUI5/OpenUI5 front end development and connected with BPMN for approval of tasks
- J2EE development around PI/PRO like webapps, adapters, modules and proxies
- Developed Java and XSLT mappings to extend the functionality of message mappings.
- Implemented EDI and AS2 solutions using B2B Addon.
- Designed architectures which are SOA compliant for the PI projects.

In the various projects he has worked, he has gained experiences with banking, sales, material management, finance, HR, warehouse and gas distribution.

Besides XI/PI he have also worked with other Netweaver technologies; ABAP(which is necessary on most projects, to enhance the integration capabilities of SAP ERP), portal, Web Dynpro for Java, J2EE and CCMS.
